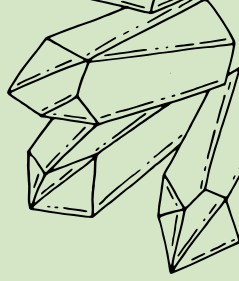

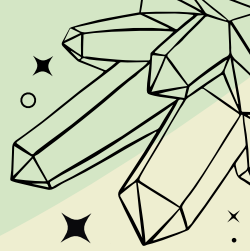
Character Development

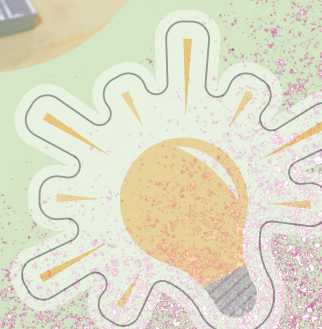


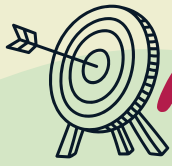
Extra Curricular Activities of EISD
